The Scholarship Request Form for the 2019 National Tribal Judicial and Court Personnel Conference is **NOW AVAILABLE**.

Through the generosity of Casey Family Programs' Indian Child Welfare Programs, NAICJA offers a limited number of scholarships to assist tribal judges to attend the 2019 National Tribal Judicial and Court Clerks Conference. The need-based scholarships assist with conference registration fees. The scholarship is available to judges or peacemakers hearing Indian child welfare matters. Scholarship recipients must attend all Indian child welfare-related training sessions.

Interested participants should act fast. Scholarships are issued on a first come, first serve basis until funding is exhausted. Due to the volume of applications and our limited scholarship funds, NAICJA may not be able to fulfill all scholarship requests.
