The National American Indian Court Judges Association ("NAICJA"), a national non-profit organization of American Indian and Alaska Native tribal court judges and tribal court personnel, is accepting registrations from qualified artisans and exhibitors for booth space at the **50**th **Annual National Tribal Judicial and Court Personnel Conference**.

Booth space for this year's conference will begin on Wednesday, October 16 and run through Thursday, October 17 (end of day). <u>Purchase of a booth does not include admission to the conference</u>. You must register for a conference ticket separately.

The conference will be held at the Mystic Lake Casino and Resort in Shakopee, Minnesota. The conference provides to nearly 300 tribal judges, peacemakers, court personnel and others interested in tribal courts, quality culturally-appropriate continuing legal education to enhance the functioning of their tribal justice systems. Participants learn about major recent court decisions and legislation as well as about emerging practices that improve the quality of tribal justice administration while maintaining fidelity to tribal traditions, customs and values. Conference attendees often find they learn greatly from the opportunity to network with their tribal court peers.
